Hello Members of TTT and Owners of Luxury Properties Worldwide,

I hope you are enjoying a festive holiday season! Our exchange fee for "self-arranged trades" is 10% of the rental value, saving you 90%. The exchange fee for "staff-arranged trades" is 20% of the rental value, saving you 80%. In other words, using the messaging system to contact owners cuts exchange fees in half.


